Thank you for your interest in able-bodied riding lessons at Avon Riding Centre. We offer weekly evening group lessons that are taken in a 26m x 56m indoor arena, which has excellent lighting for the winter months. There is no set schedule of lesson plans, however the instructor will work with the same group each week (apart from occasional holiday cover) building on your flatwork and jumping skills, with chances in the summer for hacking and cross country riding (depending on the group's ability). We currently have 25 horses and ponies which are well schooled, ranging from 12hh – 16hh from cobs to more thoroughbred types, mares and geldings.

There is a waiting list for riding lessons, the length of the wait will depend on your ability and suitable riding slots that are available. When your form is received we will confirm you are on the waiting list.

We have a café with a viewing area if you would like to visit the Centre to watch a lesson. The ideal time to watch an able-bodied lesson is Saturdays from 2:30pm to 4:00pm.
